2	6-13-1602. Administrative consolidation list.			
3	By February 1, 2004, and each January 1 thereafter of each year, the			
4	Department of Education shall publish a consolidation list that includes all			
5	school districts with fewer than three hundred fifty (350) students according			
6	to the school district average daily membership in each quarter of the two			
7	(2) school years immediately preceding the current school year.

9	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the			
10	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is uncertainty in the			
11	calculation of average daily membership when it comes to the administrative			
12	consolidation list; that school districts may be unfairly placed on the			
13	administrative consolidation list which causes a great deal of anxiety among			
14	parents, students, school district employees and communities; and that this			
15	act is immediately necessary to ensure that the factors that must be met for			
16	a school district to be placed on the administrative consolidation list are			
17	clear and understandable. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and			
18	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public

20	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
