## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE PURCHASE OF THERMAL IMAGING EQUIPMENT TO BE USED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AIRCRAFT WHEN PURCHASED BY A COUNTY GOVERNMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO EXEMPT THE PURCHASE OF THERMAL IMAGING EQUIPMENT TO BE USED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AIRCRAFT WHEN PURCHASED BY A COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 52, Subchapter 4 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

26-52-442. Thermal imaging equipment.
The gross receipts or gross proceeds derived from the sale of thermal imaging equipment purchased by a county government for use by law enforcement aircraft are exempt from the:
(1) Gross receipts tax levied by this chapter; and
(2) Compensating use tax levied by the Arkansas Compensating Tax Act of 1949, § 26-53-101 et seq.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that county governments that use county owned or county controlled aircraft for law enforcement purposes should be exempt from paying Arkansas sales and use tax on thermal imagining
