30	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - CONFERENCE EX	KPENSES. There is	hereby
31	appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be payable from cash		
32	funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Rural		
33	Services, for conference expenses of the De	partment of Rural	Services for the
34	fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the follo	owing:

4	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
6	FAIR GRANTS. The Department of Rural Services shall develop the necessary
7	rules and regulations for the disbursement of matching fund grants to county
8	fairs for the construction, renovation and/or improvements to county fair
9	grounds. The grants shall be matched on a $50/50$ basis. The match may be
10	cash or in-kind. No county fair shall receive more than \$30,000 for the
11	biennium.
12	
13	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANT
15	AWARD CRITERIA. The Department of Rural Services shall promulgate regulations
16	establishing the criteria to be utilized in determining to whom grants will
17	be made under this Act. Subject to the approval of the Governor, and
18	approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee,
19	the Department of Rural Services shall distribute the grants.
20	Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
21	appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
22	is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
23	delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
24	the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
25	amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
26	has determined that the Department of Rural Services may operate more
27	efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Rural
28	Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
29	necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
30	requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
31	as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
32	Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
33	If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
34	Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
35	this entire section is void.
36	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

1	2007 <u>2009</u> through June 30, 2009 <u>2010</u> .			
2				
3	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized			
4	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds			
5	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the			
6	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and			
7	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary			
8	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal			
9	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated b			
10	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be			
11	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.			
12				
13	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly			
14	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained			
15	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act			
16	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations			
17	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by			
18	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral			
19	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or			
20	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.			
21				
22	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General			
23	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the			
24	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the			
25	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of			
26	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in			
27	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective			
28	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the			
29	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.			
30	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being			
31	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and			
32	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
