17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-93-201 is amended to read as follows:
20 16-93-201. Creation – Members.

21 (a)(1) There is created the Parole Board, to be composed of seven (7)
22 members to be appointed from the state at large by the Governor and confirmed
23 by the Senate.

24 (2) Seven (7) members shall be full-time officials of this
25 state, one (1) of whom shall be designated by the Governor as the chair of
26 the board.

27 (3) Members shall serve seven-year terms, except that the terms
28 shall be staggered by the Governor so that the term of one (1) member expires
29 each year.

30 (4) At least one (1) member but no more than two (2) members
31 shall be from each congressional district.

32 (b) If any vacancy occurs on the board prior to the expiration of a
33 term, the Governor shall fill the vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired
34 term, subject to confirmation by the Senate at its next regular session.

35 (c) The members of the board may receive expense reimbursement and
36 stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.



1 (d) Four (4) members of the board shall constitute a quorum.

3 *SECTION 2. Do Not Codify. This act shall be implemented as vacancies*
4 *occur on the Parole Board.*
