| 29 | WHEREAS, Mayor Wilson was one of the most compassionate and caring men |
| 30 | a person could know, and words cannot accurately express the uniqueness and |
| 31 | significance of his life and the lasting impact he had on each individual |
| 32 | with whom he came into contact; and |

| 34 | WHEREAS, Mayor Wilson attended high school at the Baylor School in |
| 35 | Chattanooga, Tennessee, and graduated from The Citadel at Charleston, South |
| 36 | Carolina, in 1965: served in the United States Army in Korea: and achieved |

| 4 | WHEREAS, Mayor Wilson was the son of the late Robert Edward Lee Wilson |
| 5 | III and Patte Evans Wilson, and he was the great-grandson of Robert Edward |
| 6 | Lee Wilson, who founded Lee Wilson and Company of Wilson, Arkansas, in 1886; |

| 9 | WHEREAS, following his tour of duty in the Army, Mayor Wilson returned |
| 10 | to Wilson, Arkansas, to work at Lee Wilson and Company, where he served as |
| 11 | chairman and chief executive officer from 1987 until his death; and |

| 13 | WHEREAS, Mayor Wilson's love for the State of Arkansas was well known, |
| 14 | as was his highly respected philanthropic work, his willingness to devote |
| 15 | countless hours to charitable endeavors, and his passion for the advancement |
| 16 | of education, both on a state and national level; and |

| 18 | WHEREAS, he was described by Dr. Ruth Hawkins of the Arkansas State |
| 19 | University Delta Heritage Initiative Program as one who "understood the value |
| 20 | of education in improving lives, and he was a strong advocate for our |
| 21 | university, as well as other universities in the region"; and |

| 23 | WHEREAS, Mississippi County Judge Steve McGuire of Blytheville said |
| 24 | Wilson was a strong supporter of economic development, seeking to position a |
| 25 | third bridge across the Mississippi River; and "The citizens in our county |
| 26 | would not readily recognize the value that Mike has been for Mississippi |
| 27 | County," McGuire said. "He did not advertise what he did. He did things to |
| 28 | help the citizens of our county. He always had a different perspective, and |
| 29 | it was very positive."; and |

| 31 | WHEREAS, friend and businessman Frank Lyon said of Wilson, "If there |
| 32 | was a new program to benefit the Delta that he was not involved in, I do not |
| 33 | know what it was."; and |

| 35 | WHEREAS, Arkansas Supreme Court Justice Robert Brown describes Mayor |
| 36 | Wilson as "ultimately a man of honor and integrity who accomplished great |
