10	URGING THE GOVERNMENT OF TURKEY TO GRANT THE
11	ECUMENICAL PATRIARCH APPROPRIATE INTERNATIONAL
12	RECOGNITION, ECCLESIASTICAL SUCCESSION, AND THE
13	RIGHT TO TRAIN CLERGY OF ALL NATIONALITIES AND TO
14	RESPECT THE PROPERTY RIGHTS AND HUMAN RIGHTS OF

18	URGING THE GOVERNMENT OF TURKEY TO GRANT
19	THE ECUMENICAL PATRIARCH APPROPRIATE
20	RECOGNITION AND RIGHTS.

23	WHEREAS, the Ecumenical Patriarchate, located in Istanbul, Turkey, is
24	the Sacred See that presides in a spirit of brotherhood over a communion of
25	self-governing churches of the Orthodox Christian world; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the See is led by Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew, who is the
28	269^{th} in direct succession to the Apostle Andrew and holds titular primacy as
29	primus inter pares, meaning "first among equals", in the community of
30	Orthodox churches worldwide; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, the Orthodox Christian Church, in existence for nearly two
33	thousand (2,000) years, numbers approximately three hundred million
34	(300,000,000) members worldwide with more than two million (2,000,000)
35	members in the United States; and

1 WHEREAS, since 1453, the continuing presence of the Ecumenical 2 Patriarchate in Turkey has been a living testament to the religious coexistence of Christians and Muslims; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, this religious coexistence is in jeopardy because the 6 Ecumenical Patriarchate is considered a minority religion by the Government 7 of Turkey; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Government of Turkey has limited the candidates available 10 to hold the office of Ecumenical Patriarch to only Turkish nationals, and 11 from the millions of Orthodox Christians living in Turkey at the turn of the 12 twentieth century and due to the continued policies during this period by the Government of Turkey, there remain less than three thousand (3,000) of the 13 14 Ecumenical Patriarch's flock left in Turkey today; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the Government of Turkey closed the Theological School on the 17 Island of Halki in 1971 and has refused to allow it to reopen, thus impeding training for Orthodox Christian clergy; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, the Government of Turkey has confiscated nearly ninety-four 21 percent (94%) of the Ecumenical Patriarchate's properties and has placed a 22 tax of forty-two percent (42%), retroactive to 1999, on the Balouki Hospital 23 and Home for the Aged, a charity hospital owned by the Ecumenical 24 Patriarchate: and 25 26 WHEREAS, the European Union, a political and economic union of nation 27 states with a common goal of promoting peace and the well-being of its 28 people, began accession negotiations with Turkey on October 2, 2005; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the European Union defined membership criteria for accession at the Copenhagen European Council in 1993, obligating candidate countries to 31 32 achieve certain levels of reform, including stability of institutions 33 guaranteeing democracy, adherence to the rule of law, and respect for and 34 protection of minorities and human rights; and 35 36 WHEREAS, the Government of Turkey's current treatment of the Ecumenical

2 European Union; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Orthodox Christians in Arkansas and throughout the United 5 States stand to lose their spiritual leader because of the continued actions 6 of the Government of Turkey, 7 8 NOW THEREFORE, 9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 10 11 12 THAT the members of the Arkansas General Assembly urge the Government 13 of Turkey to: 14 (1) Uphold and safeguard religious and human rights without 15 compromise; 16 (2) Cease its discrimination of the Ecumenical Patriarchate; 17 (3) Grant the Ecumenical Patriarch appropriate international recognition, ecclesiastic succession, and the right to train clergy of all 18 19 nationalities; and 20 (4) Respect the property rights and human rights of the 21 Ecumenical Patriarchate. 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Senate transmit copies of 24 this resolution to: 25 (1)The President of the United States; 26 (2) The United States Ambassador to the Republic of Turkey; 27 (3) The Ambassador of the Republic of Turkey to the United 28 States; and 29 (4) The members of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation. 30 31 32 33 34 35
