           WHEREAS, President Clinton's election as President of the United

     States in 1992 was followed by the longest period of sustained economic

     increases early in President Clinton's first term as President and further

     budget changes in 1997 led to the elimination of deficits in the federal

     budget and to four (4) successive budget surpluses, the first time in fifty
