25	leadership of boys' basketball head coach Barry Gephart, finishing with a
26	perfect season and a 30-0 record; and

28	WHEREAS, this was the fourth overall state title for the Fayetteville
29	boys' basketball team; and

31	WHEREAS, Fred Gulley of Fayetteville was named the Class 7-A Most
32	Valuable Player for the game; and

34	WHEREAS, the Purple Bulldogs boys' basketball team posted a perfect 14-
35	O record in the Class 7A West conference and won the Class 7-A West Regular
36	Season Champion title; and

2	WHEREAS, the Purple Bulldogs boys' basketball team has been highly
3	ranked in the prestigious USA Today media poll, as well as other national
4	media polls, throughout the year; and

6	WHEREAS, the Fayetteville High School girls' basketball team, which
7	also finished the season undefeated, won the state championship for its class
8	this year, marking the first time in Arkansas history that basketball teams
9	from the same school have won state championships in the same year and, also
10	for the first time, both teams posted undefeated seasons,
