19 WHEREAS, the Fayetteville High School Purple Bulldogs took home the  
20 school's first state title in fifteen (15) years with a 72-61 victory over  
21 North Little Rock High School in the Class 7-A Girls' State Championship  
22 basketball game; and

24 WHEREAS, the Purple Bulldogs won the Class 7-A title under the  
25 leadership of girls' basketball head coach Bobby Smith, finishing with a  
26 perfect season and a 32-0 record; and

28 WHEREAS, this was the Fayetteville girls' basketball team's third  
29 overall state title win; and

31 WHEREAS, Cassie Clarke of Fayetteville was named the Class 7-A Most  
32 Valuable Player for the game; and

34 WHEREAS, the Purple Bulldogs girls' basketball team posted a perfect  
35 14-0 record in the Class 7A West conference and won the Class 7-A West  
36 Regular Season Champion title; and

2 WHEREAS, the Purple Bulldogs girls' basketball team has been highly  
3 ranked in the prestigious USA Today media poll, as well as other national  
4 media polls, throughout the year; and

6 WHEREAS, the Purple Bulldogs girls' basketball team finished as number  
7 one (1) in the South for the USA Today poll and was ranked number eight (8)  
8 overall; and  
9

10 WHEREAS, also important to note is that the Fayetteville High School  
11 boys' basketball team, which also finished the season undefeated, won the  
12 state championship for its class this year, marking the first time in  
13 Arkansas history that basketball teams from the same school have won state  
14 championships in the same year and, also for the first time, both teams  
15 posted undefeated seasons,
