NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 10 11 INTERIM EXPENSE DISBURSEMENTS. The appropriations authorized in Section 3 12 shall be used for making reimbursements for interim expenses incurred by members of the Senate. 13 14 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 17 LEGISLATIVE INSTITUTE. Members of the preceding General Assembly and the 18 newly elected members of the House of Representatives and Senate shall be 19 eligible to attend the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and shall 20 be entitled, upon filing claim therefor, to per diem in the amount fixed by 21 law for members of the General Assembly to receive for attendance at 22 Legislative sessions, for each day in attending the biennial Institute of 23 Legislative Procedure plus mileage for traveling from their place of 24 residence to the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and return. 25 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 26 27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 31 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 33 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 34 35 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 36

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1	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
2	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of		
3	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that i		
4	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
5	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm		
6	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
7	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
8	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
9	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.		
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
