9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS  
11 TOBACCO CONTROL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE  
12 30, 2011; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS TOBACCO CONTROL  
17 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-2011 FISCAL  
18 YEAR.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas  
24 Tobacco Control for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number  
25 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of  
26 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et  
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
33 successor.

13 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 14 the Arkansas Tobacco Control, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies  
 15 Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas  
 16 Tobacco Control for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

30 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - SALES TO MINORS ENFORCEMENT. There is hereby  
 31 appropriated, to the Arkansas Tobacco Control, to be payable from the cash  
 32 fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal  
 33 Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
 34 Arkansas Tobacco Control - Sales to Minors Enforcement for the fiscal year  
 35 ending June 30, 2011, the following:

13 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 16 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

22

23 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 30 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

31

32 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 34 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of  
 36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
