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24	SECTION 1. EXTRA H	ELP. There is hereby authorized, for	the Arkansas State	
25	Board of Registration of Foresters for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the			
26	following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as			
27	"Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two			
28	(2) temporary or part	-time employees, when needed, at rate	es of pay not to	
29	exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or			
30	its successor, or thi	s act for the appropriate classificat	ion.	
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32	SECTION 2. APPROPR	IATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby	appropriated, to	
33	the Arkansas State Board of Registration of Foresters, to be payable from the			
34	cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal			
35	Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the			
36	Arkansas State Board of Registration of Foresters for the fiscal year ending

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15 SECTION 3. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 16 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment 17 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 18 19 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall 20 21 determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the 22 requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the 23 agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend 24 monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if: 25 The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such (1) 26 agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and 27 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the legal counsel to be retained by the agency. 28 29 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the 30 employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such 31 32 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and

33 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.
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35 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

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1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 2 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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9 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm 24 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010. 29 30 31 32 33

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
