AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL
SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE MARTIN
LUTHER KING, JR. COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
ENDING JUNE 30, 2011; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.
COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-
2011 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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9 SECTION 4. EXTRA HELP - CASH. There is hereby authorized, for the Martin
 10 Luther King, Jr. Commission for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following
 11 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
 12 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four (4)
 13 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
 14 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 15 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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17 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 18 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 19 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 20 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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27 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 34 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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36 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
6 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
10 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
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
