15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS CRIME
16 INFORMATION CENTER APPROPRIATION FOR THE
17 2010-2011 FISCAL YEAR.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
24 Crime Information Center for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

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9 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF
11 CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AND FUNDING. In the event additional appropriation
12 becomes necessary that is not authorized or contemplated in Section 2 of this
13 Act and circumstances make it necessary for the Arkansas Crime Information
14 Center to request additional appropriation to carry out the objectives of the
15 Agency, the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be used for
16 regular salaries, personal services matching and maintenance and general
17 operation line item appropriations authorized for such programs in this Act.
18 Funding for the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be
19 transferred to the appropriate fund or fund account from such excess funds as
20 the Director of the Arkansas Crime Information Center may determine are
21 available from criminal background check fees deposited on behalf of the
22 Arkansas Crime Information Center. Use of the contingency appropriation and
23 funding authorized in this Act shall be approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer
24 of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

25 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
26 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
27 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
28 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
29 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
30 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
31 has determined that the Arkansas Crime Information Center may operate more
32 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Crime Information
33 Center authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
34 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
35 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
36 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
 2 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 3 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
 4 this entire section is void.

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6 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
 8 FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year, the Director of the Arkansas
 9 Crime Information Center shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 10 State the amount, if any, of unexpended monies in the Crime Information
 11 System Fund, or its successor, resulting from the reimbursement to the
 12 Arkansas Crime Information Center by municipal, county, state or federal
 13 governments for teleprocessing services. Any balance of such monies shall be
 14 carried forward and made available for the maintenance, operation,
 15 improvement and other necessary expenditures in providing teleprocessing
 16 services to such municipal, county, state, and federal agencies served by the
 17 Arkansas Crime Information Center. The total amount which is carried forward
 18 under the provisions of this section shall be reported in the Budget Manuals
 19 which are presented to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
 20 Committee.

21 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may
 22 be carried forward under the following conditions:

- 23 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set
 24 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
 25 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 26 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
 27 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
 28 the first fiscal year to the second fiscal year by the September Arkansas
 29 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting in the second fiscal
 30 year which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
 31 Institution and the amount of funding carried forward from the first fiscal
 32 year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding
 33 source and a copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;
- 34 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
 35 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 36 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written

1 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
 2 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
 3 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
 4 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
 5 Committee; and

6 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
 7 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
 8 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
 10 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

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 12 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 13 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 14 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 15 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 22 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 23 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 31 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 33 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
 35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 36 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.

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
