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11 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the 12 Arkansas Northeastern College for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following 13 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra 14 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five 15 hundred twenty-one (521) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at 16 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and 17 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification. 18

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20 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, 21 to the Arkansas Northeastern College, to be payable from the Arkansas 22 Northeastern College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of 23 the Arkansas Northeastern College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, 24 the following:

2 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, 3 to the Arkansas Northeastern College, to be payable from cash funds as 4 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Northeastern College, for 5 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Northeastern College 6 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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26 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 27 28 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 29 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 30 31 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 32 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 33 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 34 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 35 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 36

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release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.
The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
<u>2010</u> through June 30, 2009 <u>2011</u>.

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7 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 13 14 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 15 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 16 with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 18 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 29 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm 34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 36

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
