19	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED	INTO THE ARKANSAS			
20	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER				
21	PROVISION - LINE ITEMS. The Legislative Auditor is hereby authorized to				
22	direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfe	r appropriation			
23	between the line items of the appropriation in Section	2 of this Act in such			
24	amounts determined necessary. In no event, however, shall the Regular				
25	Salaries line item in Section 2 be increased or decreas	ed by such transfers			
26	authorized herein, until the Legislative Council or Joi	nt Budget Committee			
27	reviews such transfers.				
28	The provisions of this section shall be in effect	only from July 1,			
29	2007 2010 through June 30, 2009 2011.

31	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED	INTO THE ARKANSAS			
32	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEM	PORARY LAW. SALARIES.			
33	Employees of the Division of Legislative Audit shall be eligible for cost-of-				
34	living increases on July 1, in an amount equal to that	granted to all other			
35	state agency, board, commission or institution of higher education employees				
36	on those dates. Any additional adjustments in annual salary rates for				

- 1 Division employees, labor market adjustments, merit pay adjustments or
- 2 employee retention or recruitment requirements shall be made at the
- 3 discretion of the Legislative Auditor. In addition, the Legislative Auditor
- 4 may implement a merit program to reward employees of the Division for
- 5 exceptional service. The plan shall be approved by the Legislative Joint
- 6 Auditing Committee prior to its implementation. In order that exceptionally
- 7 well-qualified personnel may be recruited and retained, the Division of
- 8 Legislative Audit may exceed the maximum salary levels by no more than twenty
- 9 percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the positions authorized in
- 10 the appropriation act after receiving approval from the Arkansas Legislative
- 11 Council or Joint Budget Committee. Salary payments in accordance with this
- 12 section shall not be restricted to maximum amounts authorized by law.
- 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 14 2007 2010 through June 30, 2009 2011.
- 16 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDS.
- 18 In the event the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint
- 19 Auditing Committee should receive any funds in connection with performing
- 20 their duties as prescribed by the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act, such
- 21 funds shall be deposited into the State Central Services Fund to be utilized
- 22 solely by the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing
- 23 Committee in performing such duties.
- 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2009
- 25 2010 through June 30, 2010 2011.

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- 27 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 28 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 29 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 30 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
2	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
3	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
4	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
5	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
6	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
7	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
8	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
9	
10	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
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
