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## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS COURT OF APPEALS  
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-2011 FISCAL  
17 YEAR.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
24 the Arkansas Court of Appeals for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following  
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
33 or its successor.

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17 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 18 Arkansas Court of Appeals for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following  
 19 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
 20 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2)  
 21 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed  
 22 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its  
 23 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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25 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 26 the Arkansas Court of Appeals, to be payable from the State Central Services  
 27 Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, special judges, court  
 28 appointed attorneys, and other legal expenses of the Arkansas Court of  
 29 Appeals for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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11 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MILEAGE  
 13 REIMBURSEMENT. The funds appropriated in Mileage Reimbursement of Section 3  
 14 herein may be used by each judge of the Arkansas Court of Appeals as  
 15 reimbursement for necessary mileage. The mileage reimbursement shall be at  
 16 the same rate established in the state travel regulations for state employees  
 17 and shall be limited to travel within the state between the judge's official  
 18 residence and the court with mileage reimbursements not to exceed three round  
 19 trips per week. Only judges whose official residence is located outside of  
 20 Pulaski County shall be eligible to be reimbursed for mileage.

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22 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 23 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 24 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 25 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 28 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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32 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 33 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 34 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 35 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 36 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
2 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
3 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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5 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
6 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
7 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
8 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of  
9 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
10 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
11 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm  
12 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
13 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
14 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
15 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.

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
