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32 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the 33 Office of the Treasurer of State for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following 34 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra 35 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten (10) 36 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed

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those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

4 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to 5 the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central 6 Services Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, data processing 7 system/services and debt collection of the Office of the Treasurer of State 8 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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25 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 27 FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, any 28 unexpended funds provided for the Data Processing System/Services line item 29 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the 30 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

31 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may 32 be carried forward under the following conditions:

(1) Prior to June 30, 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of
Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

36 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall

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report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;

(3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 7 8 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 9 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 10 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 11 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 12 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 13 14 Committee; and

15 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include 16 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a 17 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution. 18

19 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 21 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 22 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Treasurer of 23 State is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized 24 in Section 3 Appropriation - Operations of the Treasurer's Office in this Act 25 to any other line item authorized in Section 3.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 27 <u>2007</u> <u>2010</u> through June 30, <u>2009</u> <u>2011</u>.

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29 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 30 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 31 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 32 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 35 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

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SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
