- 16 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
- 18 FORWARD. Any authorized carry forward of unexpended balance of funding, may
- 19 be carried forward under the following conditions:
- 20 (1) Prior to June 30, 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
- 21 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of
- 22 Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 23 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall

1 2 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act 4 5 shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 6 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 7 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures 8 Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, 9 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as 10 11 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said 12 funds. 13 14 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 16 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds 17 disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was 18 19 adopted, as evidenced by Initiated Act 1 of 2000, the Agency Requests, 20 Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the 21 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, 22 letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas 23 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and 24 adoption. 25 26 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 28 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 31 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm 32 33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
