32	NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>The</u>
33	reappropriation authorized for statewide grants to public libraries in this
34	Act shall not be restricted by requirements that may be applicable to other
35	programs currently administered. New rules and regulations may be adopted to
36	carry out the intent of the General Assembly regarding the appropriations

1	authorized in this Act.
2	No less than thirty (30) days prior to the distribution of any funds
3	appropriated by this act, the director of the agency shall notify the Speaker
4	of the House of Representatives of the name and address of each recipient and
5	the amount that is being distributed to each recipient.
6	The grants to public libraries authorized by this act shall be
7	distributed on a per capita basis and include public libraries that do not
8	meet the guidelines for State Aid to Public Libraries.
9	The appropriations authorized by this Act and funded through Acts 1442
10	and 1443 of 2009 to be distributed for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011
11	for statewide grants to public libraries shall be distributed directly to the
12	local libraries independent of the regional system of which they may be a
13	member.
14	

15 SECTION 31. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 16 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 17 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 18 19 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 20 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 21 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 22 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 23 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 24 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 25 26 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

34 SECTION *32*. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

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1 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 2 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 3 4 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 5 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 6 7 SECTION 33. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 8 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 9 appropriation of funds for a longer period than one (1) fiscal year; that the 10 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of 11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, with the exception that Sections 27, 28 and 29 in this Act which shall be in full 12 13 force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, and 14 that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in 15 the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable 16 harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs, with the exception that Sections 27, 28 and 29 in this Act which 17 18 shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 19 20 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 21 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010, with the exception that Sections 27, 28 and 29 in this Act which shall be in 22 23 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 24 25 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
