11	(E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

14	repair projects for all prison facilities, in a sum not to exceed		
15	\$766,861.		
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17	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS FARM PROJECTS. There is hereby		
18	appropriated, to the Department of Correction, to be payable from the		
19	Department of Correction Farm Fund, for the Department of Correction, the		
20	following:		
21	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in		
22	Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 111 of 2009, for maintenance, replacement,		
23	expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, improvement, repair,		
24	purchase, and upgrade of various Farm Projects, in a sum not to exceed		
25	\$1,881,086.		
26	(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in		
27	Section 3 of Act 517 of 2009, for maintenance, replacement, repair,		
28	expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement and		
29	upgrade of the Department of Correction - Various Farm Projects, in a sum not		
30	to exceed\$1,773,800.

32	SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS. There is hereby		
33	appropriated, to the Department of Correction, to be payable from the		
34	Department of Correction Prison Industry Fund, for the Department of		
35	Correction, the following:		
36	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in		

1 Section 3 of Act 111 of 2009, for maintenance, replacement, expansion, 2 construction, equipping, renovation, improvement, repair, purchase, and upgrade of various Industry Projects, in a sum not to exceed ...\$1,048,193. 3 4 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in 5 Section 2 of Act 517 of 2009, for maintenance, replacement, repair, 6 expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement and 7 upgrade of the Department of Correction - Various Industry Projects, in a sum 8 not to exceed\$1,245,340. 9 10 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - NORTHWEST ARKANSAS WORK RELEASE CENTER. There 11 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Correction, to be payable from 12 the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief 13 Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Correction, the following: 14 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in 15 Section 4 of Act 517 of 2009, for new building construction and related costs 16 to acquire or construct a 100-bed facility to relocate the existing 42-bed 17 work release center at Springdale, in a sum not to exceed\$3,500,000. 18 SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 19 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 20 21 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 22 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 23 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 24 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 25 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 26 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 27 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 28 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 29 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 30 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act. (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing 31 32 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue 33 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State 34 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, 35 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any 36 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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2	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly			
3	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained			
4	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act			
5	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations			
6	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by			
7	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral			
8	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or			
9	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.			
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11	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General			
12	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the			
13	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the			
14	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of			
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in			
16	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the			
17	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm			
18	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental			
19	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act			
20	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health			
21	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.			
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
