25	SECTION 1. APPROPRIAT	ION - DAVIDSONVILLE HISTORIC	STATE PARK. There is
26	hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable		
27	from the Parks and Tourism Fund Account, the following:		
28	(A) For personal services and operating expenses for a feasibility study		
29	for a proposed Visitor Center and Archeological Research Station for the		
30	Davidsonville Historic St	tate Park, the sum of	\$50,000.
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32	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE	WITH OTHER LAWS. Disburseme	nt of funds authorized
33	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds		
34	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the		
35	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
36	Budgetary Procedures Law	, the Revenue Stabilization L	aw, the Regular Salary

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6	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly		
7	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained		
8	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this ac		
9	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations		
10	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by		
11	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral		
12	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or		
13	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
14			
15	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
16	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
17	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
18	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of		
19	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that i		
20	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
21	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm		
22	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
23	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
24	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
25	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.		
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
