## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION -  
MANAGEMENT SERVICES DIVISION - STATE HEALTH  
INFORMATION EXCHANGE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT  
PROGRAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2011;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE  
AND ADMINISTRATION - MANAGEMENT SERVICES  
DIVISION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-2011  
FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE COOPERATIVE  
AGREEMENT PROGRAM - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of  
Finance and Administration - Management Services Division, to be payable from  
the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for grants and aid to state agencies  
and other entities for matching funds to implement a State Health Information  
Exchange Cooperative Agreement Program for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
2011, the following:

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4       SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
7 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14       SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23       SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
25 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of  
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
28 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
29 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm  
30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
31 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
