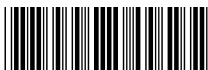
20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL  
21 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

23 That Representative Maloch is authorized to introduce a bill which, as  
24 introduced, will read substantially as follows:

35 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

1 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-5-205(e)(1)(B)(i) concerning special  
 2 revenues for the State Central Services Fund, is amended to read as follows:  
 3 (i) Those special revenues as specified in § 19-6-301(9), (11), (19), (21),
