12 EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
16 EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER
17 EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY. There is hereby
24 appropriated, to the Henderson State University, to be payable from the
25 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
26 Henderson State University, the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
28 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1394 of 2009, for equipment, personal services,
29 maintenance and operating expenses, and grants of the Rural Entrepreneurial
30 Initiative, in a sum not to exceed\$2,000,000.
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32 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
33 Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 508 of 2009, for campus renovations, in a sum
34 not to exceed\$3,100,000.
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36 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in



1 Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
2 not to exceed\$600,000.

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4 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

8 (E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

14 appropriated, to the Southern Arkansas University, to be payable from the
15 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
16 Southern Arkansas University, the following:

17 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
18 Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 508 of 2009, for construction of a University
19 Agriculture Center, in a sum not to exceed\$3,000,000.

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21 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
22 Item (B) of Section 4 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
23 not to exceed\$630,000.

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25 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
26 Item (C) of Section 4 of Act 508 of 2009, for replacement/renewal of
27 equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$50,000.

28
29 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

7 and grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and
8 Education Consortium University Center Initiatives, in a sum not to exceed
9\$1,544,400.

10
11 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
12 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1333 of 2009, for the acquisition,
13 reconstruction, remodeling, personal services and operating expenses of
14 heritage sites, in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000.

15
16 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
17 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 508 of 2009, for construction/replacement of
18 Wilson Hall, in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000.

5 operations, construction and renovations to Arkansas State University in
6 Newport, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.

7
8 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
9 Section 4 of Act 1020 of 2009, to prevent the loss of funding for personal
10 services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the
11 continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium
12 initiatives, in a sum not to exceed\$415,681.

13
14 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
15 Section 8 of Act 1020 of 2009, for personal services, operating expenses, and

21 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
22 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.

24 SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT.
25 There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable
26 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for
27 the University of Arkansas, the following:

28 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
29 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1042 of 2009, for improvements, maintenance,
30 operating, and personal services expenses for Garvan Woodland Gardens, in a
31 sum not to exceed\$100,000.

32
33 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
34 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1054 of 2009, for capital improvements and
35 operating expenses for Archeology Survey Stations, in a sum not to exceed
36\$50,000.

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(C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1059 of 2009, for classroom updates, equipment and associated costs for the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences and the Arts, in a sum not to exceed\$25,000.

14 Arkansas support and initiatives; conservation/sustainability and energy
15 workshops; strategic planning and development of conferencing capabilities
16 and locale amenities of the Institute in order to facilitate local, national,
17 and international conferences and meetings on policy matters including but

12 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
13 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1338 of 2009, for essential operations of the
14 university as determined by the Board of Trustees, general support for
15 education excellence through scholarships, equipment, technology, community
16 and economic development, and for payment of claims, in a sum not to exceed
17\$4,000,000.

18
19 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
20 Item (A) of Section 11 of Act 508 of 2009, for construction of Science
21 classrooms and labs, in a sum not to exceed\$7,000,000.

22
23 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
24 Item (B) of Section 11 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
25 not to exceed\$1,300,000.

26
27 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
28 Item (C) of Section 11 of Act 508 of 2009, for replacement/renewal of
29 equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$110,000.

30
31 (E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
32 Item (A) of Section 11 of Act 979 of 2009, for construction/renovation/
33 maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to
34 exceed\$1,000,000.

35
36 SECTION 18. REAPPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - FORT SMITH. There

1 is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith, to be
2 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
3 accounts, for the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith, the following:

4 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
5 Section 13 of Act 1020 of 2009, for information technology program related
6 personal services, operating expenses, and grants to support the continuation
7 of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium University Center
8 initiatives, in a sum not to exceed\$386,100.

9
10 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
11 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1429 of 2009, for upgrade, renovation,
12 furnishing, equipment, and expansion of the Boreham Library, in a sum not to
13 exceed\$9,500,000.

14
15 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
16 Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 508 of 2009, for expansion and upgrade of the
17 library, in a sum not to exceed\$2,500,000.

18
19 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
20 Item (B) of Section 6 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
21 not to exceed\$500,000.

22
23 (E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
24 Item (C) of Section 6 of Act 508 of 2009, for replacement/renewal of
25 equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$52,000.

26
27 (F) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
28 Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 979 of 2009, for construction/renovation/
29 maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to
30 exceed\$1,000,000.

31
32 SECTION 19. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION - GENERAL
33 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher
34 Education, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
35 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Higher Education, the following:

36 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

1 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1244 of 2009, for grants and aid for the
2 operational costs of the Arkansas Association of Two-Year Colleges Workforce
3 Training Consortium to provide services to two-year colleges statewide, in a
4 sum not to exceed\$600,000.

5
6 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
7 Item (A) of Section 34 of Act 508 of 2009, for allocation by the Director of
8 the Arkansas Department of Higher Education, to two-year colleges for
9 economic development incentive grants, in a sum not to exceed ..\$3,000,000.

10
11 SECTION 20. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION - TRUST.

12 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be
13 payable from the Higher Education Projects Development Fund, for the
14 Department of Higher Education, the following:

15 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
16 Item (A) of Section 44 of Act 299 of 2009, for the development of projects at
17 State Institutions of Higher Education and the payment of project costs and
18 expenses of the issuance of bonds of the Arkansas College Savings General
19 Obligation Bonds Program, in a sum not to exceed\$3,432,175.

20
21 SECTION 21. REAPPROPRIATION - GRANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS. There is hereby
22 appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the
23 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
24 following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided for
26 grants for scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and
27 for personal services and operating expenses as determined by the Department
28 of Higher Education for outreach programs to promote awareness of the
29 scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities, the sum of...
30\$125,000.

31
32 SECTION 22. APPROPRIATION - GRANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS. There is hereby
33 appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the
34 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for grants
35 for scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and for
36 personal services and operating expenses as determined by the Department of

1 Higher Education for outreach programs to promote awareness of the
2 scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities, for the fiscal
3 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of.....\$125,000.
4

5 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING –
7 GRANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS. As referenced in Section 3 of Act 1442 of 2009 and
8 Section 3 of Act 1443 of 2009, the authorized funding for the Department of
9 Higher Education for operating expenses and personal services for outreach
10 programs to promote awareness of scholarships and grants for scholarships for
11 Historically Black Colleges and Universities shall instead be deemed for
12 grants for scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and
13 for personal services and operating expenses as determined by the Department
14 of Higher Education for outreach programs to promote awareness of the
15 scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities.
16

17 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
19 TRANSFER - GRANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS/BOREHAM LIBRARY. Immediately upon the
20 effective date of this Section, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall
21 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
22 of the State the sum of eighteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars
23 (\$18,750) from funds deposited into the 87th Session Projects Account within
24 the General Improvement Fund for the Department of Higher Education for
25 grants for scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and
26 for personal services and operating expenses as determined by the Department
27 of Higher Education for outreach programs to promote awareness of the
28 scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities to the 87th
29 Session Projects Account within the General Improvement Fund for the
30 University of Arkansas - Fort Smith for upgrade, renovation, furnishings,
31 equipment, and expansion of the Boreham Library.

32 On July 1, 2010 or as soon thereafter as practicable the Chief Fiscal
33 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the
34 State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State an amount not to exceed six
35 thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$6,250), or so much thereof as is
36 made available during the 2010-11 fiscal year from the remaining 25% of funds

1 made available for allocation to the Legislative Division from funds
2 deposited into the 87th Session Projects Account within the General
3 Improvement Fund for the Department of Higher Education for grants for
4 scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and for
5 personal services and operating expenses as determined by the Department of
6 Higher Education for outreach programs to promote awareness of the
7 scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities to the 87th
8 Session Projects Account within the General Improvement Fund for University
9 of Arkansas - Fort Smith for upgrade, renovation, furnishings, equipment, and

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12 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
14 TRANSFER – SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY/HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY.
15 Immediately upon the effective date of this Section, the Chief Fiscal Officer
16 of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State
17 Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of thirty seven thousand five
18 hundred dollars (\$37,500) from funds deposited into the 87th Session Projects
19 Account within the General Improvement Fund for Southern Arkansas University
20 for construction / renovation / maintenance / critical maintenance /
21 equipment / library resources to the 87th Session Projects Account within the
22 General Improvement Fund for Henderson State University for construction /
23 renovation / maintenance / critical maintenance / equipment / library
24 resources.

25 On July 1, 2010 or as soon thereafter as practicable the Chief Fiscal
26 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the
27 State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State in an amount not to exceed
28 twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500), or so much thereof as is made
29 available during the 2010-11 fiscal year from the remaining 25% of funds made
30 available for allocation to the Legislative Division from funds deposited
31 into the 87th Session Projects Account within the General Improvement Fund
32 for Southern Arkansas University for construction / renovation / maintenance
33 / critical maintenance / equipment / library resources to the 87th Session
34 Projects Account within the General Improvement Fund for Henderson State
35 University for construction / renovation / maintenance / critical maintenance
36 / equipment / library resources.

1
2 SECTION 26. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
3 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
4 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
5 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
6 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
7 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
8 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
9 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
10 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
11 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
12 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
13 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

14 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
15 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
16 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
17 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
18 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
19 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

20
21 SECTION 27. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
28 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29
30 SECTION 28. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
32 appropriation of funds for a longer period than one (1) fiscal year; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, with the
35 exception that Sections 22, 23, 24 and 25 in this Act shall be in full force
36 and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in

1 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
3 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4 programs, with the exception that Sections 22, 23, 24 and 25 in this Act
5 shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and
6 approval. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
8 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010,
9 with the exception that Sections 22, 23, 24 and 25 in this Act shall be in
10 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

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
