15 AN ACT FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
16 EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER  
17 EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY. There is hereby  
24 appropriated, to the Henderson State University, to be payable from the  
25 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the  
26 Henderson State University, the following:

29 maintenance and operating expenses, and grants of the Rural Entrepreneurial  
30 Initiative, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,000,000.

33 Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 508 of 2009, for campus renovations, in a sum

16 Immediately upon the effective date of this Section, the Chief Fiscal Officer  
17 of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State  
18 Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of thirty seven thousand five  
19 hundred dollars (\$37,500) from funds deposited into the 87th Session Projects

5 in Section 3 of Act 1442 of 2009 and Section 3 of Act 1443 of 2009, the  
6 authorized funding for the University of Arkansas for construction,  
7 equipping, improvements, maintenance, and operating expenses of the Pryor  
8 Center shall instead be deemed for construction, equipping, improvements,  
9 maintenance, and personal services and operating expenses of the Pryor

12 SECTION 27. Uncodified Section 1 of Act 869 of 2009 is amended to read as  
13 follows:

14 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DAVID AND BARBARA PRYOR CENTER FOR ORAL AND  
15 VISUAL HISTORY. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas,  
16 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund  
17 accounts, the following:

18 (A) For construction, equipping, improvements, maintenance, and personal  
19 services and operating expenses of the Pryor Center for the fiscal year  
20 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of .....\$600,000.

21  
22 SECTION 28. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
23 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
24 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
25 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
26 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
27 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
28 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
29 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
30 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
31 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
32 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
33 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

34 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing  
35 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
36 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State

1 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
2 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any  
3 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.  
4

5 *SECTION 29. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.* It is the intent of the General Assembly  
6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
13

14 *SECTION 30. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.* It is found and determined by the General  
15 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
16 appropriation of funds for a longer period than one (1) fiscal year; that the  
17 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of  
18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, with the  
19 exception that Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27 in this Act shall be in  
20 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval,  
21 and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay  
22 in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable  
23 harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
24 programs, with the exception that Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27 in this  
25 Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage  
26 and approval. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this  
27 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
28 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1,  
29 2010, with the exception that Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27 in this Act  
30 shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and  
31 approval.
