12 EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY. There is hereby
24 appropriated, to the Henderson State University, to be payable from the
25 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
26 Henderson State University, the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
28 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1394 of 2009, for equipment, personal services,
29 maintenance and operating expenses, and grants of the Rural Entrepreneurial
30 *Initiative, or for construction/renovation/maintenance/critical*
31 *maintenance/equipment/library resources*, in a sum not to exceed..\$2,000,000.
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33 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
34 Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 508 of 2009, for campus renovations, in a sum
35 not to exceed\$3,100,000.
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1 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
2 Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
3 not to exceed\$600,000.
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5 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

20 Agriculture Center, in a sum not to exceed\$3,000,000.

23 Item (B) of Section 4 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
24 not to exceed\$630,000.
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26 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
27 Item (C) of Section 4 of Act 508 of 2009, for replacement/renewal of
28 equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$50,000.
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30 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

16 the Arkansas State University - Beebe, the following:

17 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
18 Item (A) of Section 13 of Act 508 of 2009, for renovation of the England
19 center, in a sum not to exceed\$1,750,000.

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21 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
22 Item (B) of Section 13 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
23 not to exceed\$320,000.

25 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
26 Item (C) of Section 13 of Act 508 of 2009, for replacement/renewal of
27 equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$75,000.

29 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

32 exceed\$1,000,000.

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34 (E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

36 classroom center, in a sum not to exceed\$2,500,000.

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SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas State University, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 11 of Act 1020 of 2009, for personal services, operating expenses, and grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium University Center Initiatives, in a sum not to exceed\$1,544,400.

(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1333 of 2009, for the acquisition, reconstruction, remodeling, personal services and operating expenses of heritage sites, in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 508 of 2009, for construction/replacement of Wilson Hall, in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000.

5 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1002 of 2009, for capital improvements,
6 operations, construction and renovations to Arkansas State University in
7 Newport, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.

9 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
10 Section 4 of Act 1020 of 2009, to prevent the loss of funding for personal
11 services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the
12 continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium
13 initiatives, in a sum not to exceed\$415,681.

15 (C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
16 Section 8 of Act 1020 of 2009, for personal services, operating expenses, and

21 (D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

26 There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable
27 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for

29 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
30 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1042 of 2009, for improvements, maintenance,
31 operating, and personal services expenses for Garvan Woodland Gardens, in a
32 sum not to exceed\$100,000.

34 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
35 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1054 of 2009, for capital improvements and
36 operating expenses for Archeology Survey Stations, in a sum not to exceed

1\$50,000.

4 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1059 of 2009, for classroom updates, equipment
5 and associated costs for the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences and

(C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 11 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$1,300,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 11 of Act 508 of 2009, for replacement/renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$110,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 11 of Act 979 of 2009, for construction/renovation/maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.

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SECTION 18. REAPPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - FORT SMITH. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 13 of Act 1020 of 2009, for information technology program related personal services, operating expenses, and grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium University Center initiatives, in a sum not to exceed\$386,100.

(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1429 of 2009, for upgrade, renovation, furnishing, equipment, and expansion of the Boreham Library, in a sum not to exceed\$9,500,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 508 of 2009, for expansion and upgrade of the library, in a sum not to exceed\$2,500,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 6 of Act 508 of 2009, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 6 of Act 508 of 2009, for replacement/renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$52,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 979 of 2009, for construction/renovation/maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.

SECTION 19. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor

1 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Higher Education, the following:

2 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
3 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1244 of 2009, for grants and aid for the
4 operational costs of the Arkansas Association of Two-Year Colleges Workforce
5 Training Consortium to provide services to two-year colleges statewide, in a
6 sum not to exceed\$600,000.

8 (B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
9 Item (A) of Section 34 of Act 508 of 2009, for allocation by the Director of
10 the Arkansas Department of Higher Education, to two-year colleges for
11 economic development incentive grants, in a sum not to exceed ..\$3,000,000.

24 appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the
25 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
26 following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided for
28 grants for scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and
29 for personal services and operating expenses as determined by the Department
30 of Higher Education for outreach programs to promote awareness of the
31 scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities, the sum of...
32\$125,000.

34 SECTION 22. APPROPRIATION - GRANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS. There is hereby
35 appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the

1 for scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and for
2 personal services and operating expenses as determined by the Department of
3 Higher Education for outreach programs to promote awareness of the

7 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING –
9 GRANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS. As referenced in Section 3 of Act 1442 of 2009 and
10 Section 3 of Act 1443 of 2009, the authorized funding for the Department of
11 Higher Education for operating expenses and personal services for outreach
12 programs to promote awareness of scholarships and grants for scholarships for
13 Historically Black Colleges and Universities shall instead be deemed for
14 grants for scholarships for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and

16 TRANSFER – SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY/HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY.
17 Immediately upon the effective date of this Section, the Chief Fiscal Officer
18 of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State
19 Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of thirty seven thousand five
20 hundred dollars (\$37,500) from funds deposited into the 87th Session Projects
21 Account within the General Improvement Fund for Southern Arkansas University

15 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DAVID AND BARBARA PRYOR CENTER FOR ORAL AND
16 VISUAL HISTORY. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas,
17 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
18 accounts, the following:

19 (A) For construction, equipping, improvements, maintenance, and personal
20 services and operating expenses of the Pryor Center for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of\$600,000.

23 SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
24 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. As referenced
25 in Section 3 of Act 1442 of 2009 and Section 3 of Act 1443 of 2009, the
26 authorized funding for the Henderson State University for equipment, personal
27 services, maintenance and operating expenses, and grants of the Rural
28 Entrepreneurial Initiative shall be deemed to also include construction/
29 renovation/maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library resources.

30
31 SECTION 29. Uncodified Section 1 of Act 1394 of 2009 is amended to read as
32 follows:

33 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - RURAL
34 ENTREPRENEURIAL INITIATIVE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson
35 State University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
36 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

1 (A) For equipment, personal services, maintenance and operating expenses,
2 and grants of the Rural Entrepreneurial Initiative, or for
3 construction/renovation/maintenance/critical maintenance/equipment/library
4 resources, the sum of ...\$2,000,000.

5
6 SECTION 30. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
7 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
8 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
9 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
10 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
11 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
12 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
13 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
14 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
15 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
16 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
17 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

18 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
19 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
20 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
21 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
22 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
23 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

24
25 SECTION 31. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
26 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
27 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
28 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
29 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
30 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
31 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
32 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

33
34 SECTION 32. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
35 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
36 appropriation of funds for a longer period than one (1) fiscal year; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, with the
3 exception that Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 29 in this Act shall
4 be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and
5 approval, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session,
6 the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work
7 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
8 governmental programs, with the exception that Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26
9 27, 28, and 29 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after
10 the date of its passage and approval. Therefore, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from
13 and after July 1, 2010, with the exception that Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26,
14 27, 28, and 29 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after
15 the date of its passage and approval.
