SECTION 1 of Act 914 of 2009 is amended to read as follows: 7 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - NON PROFIT SUPPORT GRANT. There is hereby 8 appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Volunteerism, 9 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund 10 accounts, the following: 11 (A) For a grant for personal services and operating expenses to an 12 eligible entity that provides non profit support throughout the State of 13 Arkansas, the sum of .....\$2,000,000. 14 15 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BED 17 EXPANSION. As referenced in Section 1 of Act 506 of 2009, the authorized funding and appropriation for the Department of Human Services - Division of 18 Administrative Services for maintenance, renovation, equipping, construction, 19 20 acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair projects for all state-owned real property and facilities department-wide, shall also be deemed to include 21 22 the expansion of available statewide mental health beds to serve individuals 23 with mental illness in Arkansas. 24 SECTION 14. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 25 26 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 27 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 28 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 29 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 30 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 31

32 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects33 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds

34 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 35 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 36 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

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1 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing 2 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue 3 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State 4 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, 5 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any 6 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law. 7

8 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 14 15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 18 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010, with the exception that Sections 20 12 and 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the 21 22 date of its passage and approval, is essential to the operation of the agency 23 for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date 24 of this Act beyond July 1, 2010, with the exception that Sections 12 and 13 25 26 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its 27 passage and approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper 28 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 29 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the 30 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010, with the exception that 31 Sections 12 and 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and 32 33 after the date of its passage and approval. 34 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 35 36
