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21	SECTION 1. REAPPROP	RIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There	is hereby
22	appropriated, to the Do	epartment of Parks and Tourism, to be	e payable from the
23	General Improvement Fu	nd or its successor fund or fund acco	ounts, for the
24	Department of Parks and	d Tourism, the following:	
25	(A) Effective July	1, 2010, the balance of the appropri	ation provided in
26	Item (A) of Section 1	of Act 1149 of 2009, for grants to ci	ties and counties
27	for maintenance and ope	eration, construction and personal se	rvices for
28	community recreation a	ctivities, ball parks, sports complex	es and parks, in a
29	sum not to exceed		\$800,000.
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31	(B) Effective July	1, 2010, the balance of the appropri	ation provided in
32	Item (A) of Section 1	of Act 1160 of 2009, for grants for e	quipment,

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36	(C) Effective July	1, 2010, the balance of the appropri	ation provided in

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5	(D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

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11	(E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in

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35	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
36	to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the federal funds

1	as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of
2	Parks and Tourism, the following:
3	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
4	Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 112 of 2009, for funding to begin construction
5	of facilities planned to support the establishment of the Mississippi River
6	State Park, in a sum not to exceed\$280,800.
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8	(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
9	Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 112 of 2009, for funding to design, construct,
10	repair and renovate Airport Infrastructure at the Petit Jean State Park
11	Airport, in a sum not to exceed\$261,485.
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13	SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CONSERVATION TAX. There is hereby
14	appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the
15	Department of Parks and Tourism Fund Account, for the Department of Parks and
16	Tourism, the following:
17	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
18	Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 112 of 2009, for construction projects at
19	various parks system-wide, in a sum not to exceed\$13,324,166.
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21	(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
22	Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 112 of 2009, for construction projects at
23	various parks system-wide, in a sum not to exceed\$11,159,288.
24	
25	(C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
26	Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 112 of 2009, for special maintenance projects at
27	various parks system-wide, in a sum not to exceed\$1,425,936.
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29	(D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
30	Item (5) of Section 6 of Act 1330 of 2009, for construction, in a sum not to
31	exceed\$11,916,293.

33	(E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
34	Item (6) of Section 6 of Act 1330 of 2009, for special maintenance, in a sum
35	not to exceed\$1,732,015.
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2	SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS AND CONSTRUCTION - CASH FUNDS.
3	There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be
4	payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by
5	the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Parks and
6	Tourism, the following:
7	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
8	Item (A) of Section 8 of Act 112 of 2009, for construction, in a sum not to
9	exceed\$127,085.
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11	SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, to
12	the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural
13	and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Parks and
14	Tourism, the following:
15	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
16	Section 30 of Act 1228 of 2009, for the acquisition, management, stewardship
17	or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures
18	or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000.
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20	SECTION 6. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
21	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
22	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
23	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
24	agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
25	donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
26	funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
27	Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
28	enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
29	otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
30	Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
31	not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
32	(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
33	Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
34	Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
35	and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,

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as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any

1	funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.
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3	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
5	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
6	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
7	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
9	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
10	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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12	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
15	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
16	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
18	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
19	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
20	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
21	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
22	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
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
