30	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
31	to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the federal funds
32	as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of
33	Parks and Tourism, the following:
34	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
35	Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 112 of 2009, for funding to begin construction
36	of facilities planned to support the establishment of the Mississippi River

1	State Park, in a sum not to exceed\$280,800.
2	
3	(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
4	Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 112 of 2009, for funding to design, construct,
5	repair and renovate Airport Infrastructure at the Petit Jean State Park
6	Airport, in a sum not to exceed\$261,485.
7	
8	SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CONSERVATION TAX. There is hereby
9	appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the
10	Department of Parks and Tourism Fund Account, for the Department of Parks and
11	Tourism, the following:
12	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
13	Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 112 of 2009, for construction projects at
14	various parks system-wide, in a sum not to exceed\$13,324,166.
15	
16	(B) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
17	Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 112 of 2009, for construction projects at
18	various parks system-wide, in a sum not to exceed\$11,159,288.
19	
20	(C) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
21	Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 112 of 2009, for special maintenance projects at
22	various parks system-wide, in a sum not to exceed\$1,425,936.
23	
24	(D) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
25	Item (5) of Section 6 of Act 1330 of 2009, for construction, in a sum not to
26	exceed\$11,916,293.
27	
28	(E) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
29	Item (6) of Section 6 of Act 1330 of 2009, for special maintenance, in a sum
30	not to exceed\$1,732,015.
31	
32	
33	SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS AND CONSTRUCTION - CASH FUNDS.
34	There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be
35	payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by
36	the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Parks and

1	Tourism, the following:
2	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
3	Item (A) of Section 8 of Act 112 of 2009, for construction, in a sum not to
4	exceed\$127,085.
5	
6	SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, to
7	the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural
8	and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Parks and
9	Tourism, the following:
10	(A) Effective July 1, 2010, the balance of the appropriation provided in
11	Section 30 of Act 1228 of 2009, for the acquisition, management, stewardship
12	or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures
13	or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000.
14	
15	SECTION 6. SECTION 1 of Act 893 of 2009 is amended to read as follows:
16	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated,
17	to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the General
18	Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:
19	— (A) For grants for construction, renovation, maintenance and purchase of
20	equipment for parks and recreational facilities, the sum of
21	······\$5,000,000.
22	
23	SECTION 7. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
24	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
25	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
26	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
27	agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
28	donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
29	funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
30	Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
31	enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
32	otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
33	Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
34	not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
35	(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
36	Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue

1	Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
2	and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
3	as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
4	funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.
5	
6	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
7	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
8	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
9	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
10	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
11	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
12	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
13	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
14	
15	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
18	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010, with the exception that Section 6
19	in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
20	passage and approval, is essential to the operation of the agency for which
21	the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an
22	extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this
23	Act beyond July 1, 2010, with the exception that Section 6 in this Act shall
24	be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and
25	approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
26	provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
27	hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
28	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
29	and effect from and after July 1, 2010, with the exception that Section 6 in
30	this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
31	passage and approval.
