20	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE

22	OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to

32	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE		
33	NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEGISLATIVE		
34	INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed		
35	under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in		
36	compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as		
50	complement with the stated reasons for which this det was despited, as		

1 evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative 2 Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the 3 4 official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 5 Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 6 7 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 8 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 9 the Arkansas State University and the University of Arkansas for Medical 10 Sciences are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas 11 State University and the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of 12 13 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas State University and the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to continue such 14 15 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work 16 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential 17 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 18 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the 19 20 date of its passage and approval. 21 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 22 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 23 may veto the bill.
