1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 2 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 3 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 4 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 5 6 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 14 15 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 16 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 17 the Arkansas Building Authority are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Building Authority to continue to provide 18 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide 19 20 the necessary monies for the Arkansas Building Authority to continue such 21 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work 22 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential 23 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 24 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 25 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the 26 date of its passage and approval. 27 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 28 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 29 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 30 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 31 the veto. 32 33 34 35 36
