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        SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. INVESTMENTS. All such funds as are held at

     any time in the Death and Permanent Total Disability Trust Fund, Second

        SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

        SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
