10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE

12 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL ENFORCEMENT DIVISION  
13 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2011; AND FOR  
14 OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

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18 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
19 ADMINISTRATION - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE  
20 CONTROL ENFORCEMENT DIVISION  
21 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-2011 FISCAL  
22 YEAR.  
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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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27 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
28 established for the Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic  
29 Beverage Control Enforcement Division for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the  
30 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
31 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
32 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
33 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
34 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
35 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
36 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions



1 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
 2 101), or its successor.

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 14 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,

 17 Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of  
 18 Finance and Administration - Alcoholic Beverage Control Enforcement Division  
 19 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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 33 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 34 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic  
 35 Beverage Control Enforcement Division, to be payable from the federal funds  
 36 as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating

1 expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic Beverage  
 2 Control Enforcement Division for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the

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 17 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 18 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 19 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 20 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 27 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 34 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 36 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
2 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of  
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
5 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
6 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm  
7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
10 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.

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
