16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION ON
17 LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING
18 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-2011 FISCAL
19 YEAR.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
26 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the 2010-2011 fiscal
27 year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall
28 be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation
29 Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws
30 amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific
31 maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
32 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
33 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
34 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
35 101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - State Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

 13 of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, for
 14 operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards
 15 and Training - Special Training for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the

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28 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - DRUG DETECTION TRAINING - FEDERAL. There is
 29 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards
 30 and Training, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief
 31 Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses of the Arkansas
 32 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - Drug Detection for the
 33 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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9 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
 11 FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of funds authorized for Capital Outlay in
 12 Section 2 of this Act on June 30, 2010, shall be carried forward and made
 13 available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
 14 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may
 15 be carried forward under the following conditions:

- 16 (1) Prior to June 30, 2010, the Agency shall by written statement set forth
 17 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of
 18 Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 19 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
 20 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
 21 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
 22 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 23 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
 24 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
 25 and the amount of funding carried forward from the first fiscal year to the
 26 second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding source and a
 27 copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;
- 28 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
 29 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 30 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
 31 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
 32 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
 33 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
 34 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
 35 Committee; and
- 36 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include

1 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
2 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.

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4 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
7 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
25 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
29 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
31 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
