16 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
24 established for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - State Operations
25 for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular
26 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
27 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
28 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
29 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
30 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
31 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
32 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
33 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - State Operations for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - State Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the following:

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6 SECTION 4. REGULAR SALARIES - TRIAL PUBLIC DEFENDER OFFICE. There is

7 hereby established for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Trial Public

8 Defender Office for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number

9 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of

10 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et

11 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,

12 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein

13 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform

14 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions

15 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular

16 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its

 6 authorized, for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Trial Public
 7 Defender Office for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number
 8 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable
 9 from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or
 10 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
 11 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 12 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

1 established for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Ombudsman Program
 2 for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular
 3 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
 4 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
 5 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
 6 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
 7 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
 8 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
 9 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and

 20 appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, to be payable from
 21 the State Central Services Fund, for personal services of the Arkansas Public
 22 Defender Commission - Ombudsman Program for the fiscal year ending June 30,
 23 2011, the following:

31 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE
 33 GENERATION AND SUPPORT - COURTS. Unless specified otherwise in Arkansas Code
 34 §5-4-303(g) and Arkansas Code 16-87-213 the monies collected by the courts
 35 under the authority of §5-4-303(g) and 16-87-213 shall be deposited into the
 36 State Treasury to the credit of the State Central Services Fund.

1 In the event that the law requires that the fees levied under §5-4-
2 303(g) be deposited into the State Administration of Justice Fund, the State
3 Treasurer shall transfer the amount of the fees collected each month under
4 the authority of Arkansas Code §5-4-303(g) from the State Administration of
5 Justice Fund to the State Central Services Fund.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
7 ~~2007~~ 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

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9 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE
11 GENERATION AND SUPPORT - BAIL BOND FEES. Unless specified otherwise in
12 Arkansas Code §17-19-301(e) the monies collected by each bail bond company
13 under the authority of §17-19-301(e) shall be deposited into the State
14 Treasury to the credit of the Public Defender User Fees Fund within the State
15 Central Services Fund.

16 Of the fee collected by each licensed professional bail bond company,
17 three dollars (\$3.00) shall be transferred to the various Counties for the
18 sole purpose of defraying the operating expenses of the local public
19 defenders' office. The remaining monies collected shall be used to defray
20 operating expenses of the Commission.

21 On a quarterly basis, from the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line
22 item, the Commission shall remit to each County its portion of the three
23 dollars (\$3.00) per bail bond fee collected based upon the formula used for
24 state aid for counties. This formula is as follows: 75% of the money is
25 distributed equally to all 75 Counties and the remaining 25% is distributed
26 per capita.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
28 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

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30 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
32 PROVISION. If the Public Defender Commission should determine that the
33 appropriations made available for payments to the Counties are insufficient,
34 appropriation may be transferred from the Public Defender Commission Program
35 line item to the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item, after receiving
36 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
2 ~~2007~~ 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

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4 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DUTIES OF
6 DEPENDENCY-NEGLECT APPEALS ATTORNEY. The Public Defender Commission shall
7 utilize Dependency-Neglect Appeals Attorneys exclusively to write appeals in
8 dependency-neglect cases.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
10 ~~2007~~ 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

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12 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
13 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC
14 DEFENDERS. *(a) No funds appropriated herein shall be used for expenses in*
15 *cases where a defendant is represented by retained counsel who have not gone*
16 *through the Public Defender Commission's attorney qualification and*
17 *designation process as established by state law and the Commission's*
18 *regulations.*

19 (b) The Public Defender Commission may approve exemptions to subsection
20 (a) as needed.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
22 through June 30, 2011.

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24 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
25 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
26 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
27 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
31 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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34 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

1 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
2 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
3 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
4 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
5 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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7 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
10 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
13 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
14 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
15 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
16 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
17 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
