SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

TRANSFERS. If the Speaker of the House and the Coordinator of House Legislative Services Chief of Staff or his designee determine that any item or portion thereof appropriated herein for a specific purpose is not needed for such purposes, they may certify such fact to the State Auditor, and the

State Auditor shall cause transfer to be made from one item to another.

SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USES OF APPROPRIATION. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be used to defray the expenses of the House of Representatives of the Legislative Session of the Eighty-seventh Eighty-eighth General Assembly, and upon adjournment of the Legislative Session, any unexpended balance of the funds appropriated in this Act may be used to defray the necessary expenses of the operation of the Office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Office of the Coordinator of House Legislative Services, the Office of Parliamentarian, the Chief Clerk's Office, House Constituency Services Office and other reasonable and necessary expenses of the House of Representatives of the Eighty-seventh Eighty-eighth General Assembly incurred during the interim between the adjournment of the Legislative Session of the Eighty-seventh Eighty-eighth General Assembly and July 1, 2010 2011.

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presence, assistance, oversight and expertise of any House member is needed in the interim between the legislative sessions, and if it is determined by the Speaker of the House that certain expenses and per diem of members of the House should be paid by the House, such expenses and per diem at the rate authorized for attending legislative sessions shall be paid from the funds appropriated herein for Maintenance, Operations and Expenses.

SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY LEVELS. The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Coordinator of House Legislative Services Chief of Staff or his designee shall, during the

1 month of June, each fiscal year, meet and determine the actual salaries to be 2 paid each employee beginning the following July 1. Such salaries of the employees will be based upon an evaluation of the performance of the 3 4 Coordinator of House Legislative Services Chief of Staff by the Speaker of 5 the House of Representatives and upon an evaluation of the performance of the 6 other employees by the Coordinator of House Legislative Services Chief of 7 Staff or his designee. The Parliamentarian of the House of Representatives 8 may be paid a per diem up to such amount as is authorized for members of the 9 General Assembly each day the General Assembly is in legislative session. 10 The Coordinator of House Legislative Services and the Parliamentarian may be 11 provided an expense allowance up to such amount as is authorized for 12 reimbursable expenses for members of the General Assembly. Such per diem 13 shall be paid from the appropriation provided in Section 1 of this Act. The 14 expense allowance and associated personal services matching costs, if any, 15 are to be paid from the appropriations for Personal Services provided in the 16 appropriation act for personal services and operating expenses for the 17 Arkansas House of Representatives for the fiscal year. 18 19 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code § 10-2-215(a)(1), 20 concerning additional compensation for committee chairs, vice-chairs, and 21 cochairs, is amended to read as follows: 22 (a)(1) In addition to the expense allowance provided by § 10-2-212 and 23 all laws amendatory and supplemental thereto, the chair of each of the 24 standing, select, and joint committees of either house of the General 25 Assembly, the cochairs of the Legislative Council and the chairs of each 26 subcommittee of the Legislative Council, the cochairs of the Legislative 27 Joint Auditing Committee and the chairs of each subcommittee of the 28 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, the Speaker of the House of 29 Representatives, the Speaker Pro Tempore of the House of Representatives, the 30 Assistant Speakers Pro Tempore of the House of Representatives, the Speaker Designate of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore 31 32 Designate, the House and Senate chairs of the Review/PEER Subcommittee, the 33 Personnel Subcommittee, the Claims Subcommittee, and the Special Language 34 Subcommittee of the Joint Budget Committee, and the cochair of any committee 35 of the General Assembly which does not function during the legislative 36 session shall be eligible to receive an additional three thousand six hundred

1	dollars (\$3,600) per year.		
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3	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
4	Assembly, that the House of Representatives of the 88th General Assembly		
5	convenes in regular session on January 10, 2011; that expenses of the session		
6	begin immediately; and that the expenses are a just expense of the state		
7	which must be paid at the time the services are provided. Therefore, an		
8	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the		
9	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in		
10	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.		
11	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become		
12	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor		
13	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
14	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides		
15	the veto.		
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
