18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 1-4-106 is amended to read as follows:*

21 *1-4-106. State nickname.*

22 Because of ~~our unsurpassed scenery, clear lakes, free-flowing streams,~~
23 ~~magnificent rivers, meandering bayous, delta bottomlands, forested mountains,~~
24 ~~and abundant fish and wildlife~~ the future outlook for the development of
25 business, industry, and agriculture in this state, the official nickname for
26 the State of Arkansas is proclaimed to be "~~The Natural State~~" "The Land of
27 Opportunity".
