19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 2 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 6-60-214. In-state tuition – United States citizenship or legal
24 residency required.

25 (a)(1) A person shall be a United States citizen or legal resident to
26 be eligible for an in-state tuition benefit at a state-supported institution
27 of higher education.

28 (2) A person who is not a United States citizen or legal
29 resident shall be considered an out-of-state resident for the purposes of
30 tuition at a state-supported institution of higher education.

31 (b) The Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board may promulgate
32 rules necessary to implement this section.
