21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 2 is amended
24	to add an additional section to read as follows:
25	<u>6-60-214. In-state tuition — United States citizenship or <i>lawful</i></u>
26	presence required.
27	(a)(l) A person shall be a United States citizen or <i>lawfully present</i>
28	in the United States to be eligible for an in-state tuition benefit at a
29	state-supported institution of higher education.
30	(2) A person who is not a United States citizen or <i>lawfully</i>
31	present in the United States shall be considered an out-of-state resident for
32	the purposes of tuition at a state-supported institution of higher education.
33	(b) The Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board may promulgate
34	rules necessary to implement this section.
