2	chapter is found by the Contractors Licensing Board to knowingly employ
3	workers without legal status either directly or through a subcontractor, the
4	board may:
5	(A) Impose civil penalties against the contractor in an
6	amount not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200) per day for each day the
7	violation continues;
8	(B) Suspend the contractor's certificate of license; or
9	(C) Revoke the contractor's certificate of license.
10	(2) A contractor shall not be found to knowingly employ workers
11	without legal status if the contractor uses the federal E-verify system to
12	verify the legal status of employees. Use of the federal E-verify system is
13	an affirmative defense under this section.
14	(c) The board shall promulgate rules necessary to carry out the
15	provisions of this section.
