23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GEN	IERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF	ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. NOT TO	BE CODIFIED. This act shall	be known and may be
26	cited as the "Nick Bacon	Remembrance Act".

28	SECTION 2. Arkans	eas Code Title 27, Chapter 16,	Subchapter 8 is amended
29	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
30	<u>27-16-812. Vetera</u>	n designation.	
31	(a)(l) A person m	nay apply to the Office of Driv	er Services to obtain a
32	veteran designation on a driver's license or identification card issued under		
33	this subchapter by providing:		
34	<u>(A) A</u>	United States Department of D	efense discharge
35	document, otherwise know	n as a DD Form 214, that shows	a discharge status of
36	"honorable" or "general under honorable conditions" that establishes the		

1	person's service in the armed forces of the United States; and		
2	(B) Payment of the fee for the driver's license or		
3	identification card authorized under this chapter.		
4	(2) If the person is seeking a duplicate or substitute driver's		
5	license with the veteran designation and his or her driver's license has not		
6	expired, the fee shall be as provided under § 27-16-806.		
7	(b) The Office of Driver Services may:		
8	(1) Determine the appropriate placement of the veteran		
9	designation on the driver's licenses and identification cards authorized		
10	under this section; and		
11	(2) Promulgate the necessary rules for the administration of		
12	this section.		
13			
14	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
15	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that a person's status as a veteran		
16	can easily be included on a driver's license; that this information can be		
17	helpful for the veteran to secure benefits more easily; that having this		
18	information on driver's licenses can be helpful to law enforcement,		
19	especially when the veteran has recently returned from combat, as many of our		
20	young veterans have; and that this act is immediately necessary because it		
21	will streamline administrative procedures for veterans and assist law		
22	enforcement. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being		
23	immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and		
24	safety shall become effective on:		
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
28	bill; or		
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
