Arkansas Code § 24-4-520 is amended to read as follows: 12 24-4-520. Termination required for retirement. 13 (a) Except as provided in subsection (e) (d) of this section, a member 14 of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System shall terminate covered 15 employment to be eligible for retirement. 16 (b)(1) A member who is participating in a public employee retirement 17 system deferred retirement option plan on July 1, 2011, or a member who has 18 retired and commenced receiving benefits in any month between January 2011 19 and June 2011, inclusive, shall not be terminated from employment for 20 retirement purposes if the person: 21 (A) Returns to employment in a position covered under the 22 system within one hundred eighty (180) days of the person's effective date of 23 retirement; or 24 (B) Is a member with service credit under § 24-4-521 at a 25 rate of two (2) or more years of credited service for each year of actual 26 service and the person returns to employment in a position covered under the 27 system within one hundred eighty (180) days of the person's effective date of 28 retirement. 29 (2) A member participating in the Arkansas Public Employees' 30 Retirement System Deferred Retirement Option Plan on January 1, 2009, shall 31 have the one-hundred-eighty-day separation requirement waived and may return 32 to employment otherwise covered by the system no sooner than thirty (30) 33 calendar days from the commencement of his or her retirement. 34 (3) A member who has retired and commenced receiving benefits in 35 any month between January 2009 and June 2009, inclusive, shall have the one-36 hundred-eighty-day separation requirement waived and may return to employment

- 1 otherwise covered by the system no sooner than thirty (30) calendar days from 2 the commencement of his or her retirement.
- 3 (c) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a member may return to employment in a position covered under a public employee retirement system of the state in which the member agrees to:

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- (1) Forfeit his or her retirement benefits while employed in a position covered under a public employee retirement system; and
- 8 (2) Forfeit receipt of credited service during the period he or 9 she is employed in a position covered under a public employee retirement 10 system.
- 11 (e)(1) (d)(1) An elected public official may retire and begin 12 receiving retirement benefits if the elected public official is a member:
- 13 (A) Whose current service in public office in one (1) form 14 of government is covered by § 24-4-521(b)(5); and
- 15 (B) Who is elected to public office in a different form of 16 government and will begin serving in that public office immediately after the 17 expiration of his or her term of public office described in subdivision 18  $\frac{(c)(1)(A)}{(d)(1)(A)}$  of this section.
  - (2) The member shall notify the retirement system of his or her impending service in another form of government at least thirty (30) days prior to the first day of the month in which that service will begin. A completed retirement application shall be submitted at that time.

  - (d) (e) Persons failing to meet termination requirements shall forfeit their benefits until requirements are met.

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-7-502 is amended to read as follows: 28 29 24-7-502. Termination of active membership.
- (a)(1) A member of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System shall 30 31 terminate covered employment to be eligible for retirement.
- 32 (2)(A) Effective July 2, 2009, Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, a member shall not be terminated from employment for 33 purposes of retirement eligibility if within one hundred eighty (180) days of 34 35 the member's effective date of retirement the member:
- 36 (i) Meets both of the following requirements:

- 1 (a) Becomes employed with an employer covered 2 by the system; and 3 (b) Has not attained the system's normal 4 retirement age; or 5 (ii) Does not have total or a combined total of 6 thirty-eight (38) years or more of credited service in the system, T-DROP, or 7 reciprocal service in another eligible state retirement system. 8 (B) If a member has a combined total of thirty-eight (38) 9 years or more of credited service in the system, T-DROP, or reciprocal 10 credited service in another eligible state retirement system, then the member 11 shall not be terminated from employment for purposes of retirement 12 eligibility if within thirty (30) days of the member's effective date of 13 retirement the member: 14 (i) Becomes employed with an employer covered by the 15 system; and 16 Has not attained the system's normal retirement (ii) 17 age. 18 (3) A member who fails to meet the termination requirement of 19 this subsection shall forfeit all retirement benefits until the termination 20 requirement is met. 21 (4)(A) A member shall repay to the system any retirement 22 benefits that are paid to the member by the system during the waiting period 23 of one hundred eighty (180) days in subdivision (a)(2) of this section. 24 (B) The system may require the repayment of retirement 25 benefits from the member indirectly under the system's standard withholding 26 rule. 27 For a member who fails to meet the termination requirement 28 in subdivisions (a)(1) and (2) of this section, the member shall immediately 29 become an active member of the system upon reemployment by a covered 30 employer. 31 (b)(1) When a member is no longer employed by an employer in a 32 position covered by the system, the person shall cease to be an active member of the system. 33
  - (2) If an inactive member has not retired and later becomes reemployed by an employer in a position covered by the system, the person shall become an active member and be eligible to accrue additional service

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1 credit. 2 (3) If the member's service during reemployment is for less than 3 thirty (30) days, he or she shall be considered to be an inactive member at 4 the termination of the reemployed service, and the only monthly benefits 5 payable shall be those provided by § 24-7-707. 6 (4)(A) An active member shall receive credit for any previous 7 unreported service after July 1, 1937, upon paying to the system the member 8 contributions in effect during the previous service, together with interest 9 from the dates of the service to the date of payment in full. 10 (B) For previous service rendered before July 1, 1971, 11 service credit shall be permitted for service in a fiscal school year only if 12 at least one hundred twenty (120) days of service were rendered in the fiscal 13 school year. 14 (c) Upon a member's retirement, the person shall cease to be an active 15 member and, except as otherwise provided in this act, he or she shall not 16 accrue additional service credit or make contributions to the system. 17 (d)(1) A member participating in a public employee retirement system 18 deferred retirement option plan on July 1, 2011, may return to employment 19 otherwise covered by the system no sooner than one hundred eighty (180) 20 calendar days from the commencement of his or her retirement. (2) A member who has retired and commenced receiving benefits in 21 22 any month between January 2011 and June 2011, inclusive, may return to 23 employment otherwise covered by the system no sooner than one hundred eighty (180) calendar days from the commencement of his or her retirement. 24 25 (3) A member may return to employment in a position covered under a public employee retirement system of the state in which the member 26 27 agrees to: 28 (A) Forfeit his or her retirement benefits while employed 29 in a position covered under a public employee retirement system; and 30 (B) Forfeit receipt of credited service during the period he or she is employed in a position covered under a public employee 31 32 retirement system.

- 36 (a) A retirant under this chapter who is not required to receive

1 mandatory distributions may rescind the decision to retire and may become an 2 active member upon employment by a covered employer. (b) A retirant who rescinds his or her decision to terminate his or 3 4 her retirement shall file a written election to rescind on the form furnished 5 by the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. 6 (c) The rescission under subsection (b) of this section is effective 7 the first day of the calendar month next following the date the written 8 election to rescind is received by the system. 9 (d)(1) Upon rescission, a retirant shall be considered an active 10 member and shall accrue additional credited service subject to the provisions 11 of subsection (e) of this section. 12 (2) Any retirement annuity previously due from the system shall be terminated upon the effective date of the rescission. 13 14 (e)(1)(A) If a retirant who has elected to rescind his or her 15 retirement terminates covered employment before he or she has accumulated at 16 least one (1) year of additional credited service, the member's retirement 17 benefits shall resume at the same benefit amount prior to the rescission. (B) If the member retires again before serving the 18 required additional one (1) year of service under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of 19 this section, the system shall refund without interest: 20 21 (i) A member contribution that is credited to the system after the election to rescind retirement; and 22 (ii) A member contribution that is not included in 23 24 the member's retirement benefits. 25 (2) If reemployment terminates after the end of the fiscal year 26 in which the former retirant has accumulated at least one (1) year of additional credited service, the rescinded member shall receive an annuity 27 that has been recalculated according to the benefit formula in effect at the 28 time of the termination of reemployment. 29 30 (f)(1) A retirant under § 24-7-702 may rescind the decision to retire and may elect to participate in the Teacher Deferred Retirement Option Plan 31 32 beginning in the next fiscal year after the date the member meets the 33 eligibility requirements. (2) If a rescinded member terminates covered employment before 34 he or she is entitled to at least one (1) year of additional credited 35

service, then the member shall forfeit any additional benefit accruals

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     credited after the effective date of rescission.
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           (g) The election to rescind under this section may be exercised only
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     once by the member or retirant.

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     increased by the reemployment.
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                 (2)(A) If a former member who is participating in a public
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     employee reitrement system deferred retirement option plan on July 1, 2011,
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     or who has retired and commenced receiving benefits in any month between
     January 2011 and June 2011, inclusive, and is entitled to a vested annuity
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     under § 24-10-611 reenters covered employment after becoming a retirant, the
     former member may again become a member with previous credited service
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     restored and increased by the period of reemployment, but only if the former

Arkansas Code § 24-11-827 is amended to read as follows: 24 25 24-11-827. Retired member returning to active status. 26 (a) For a member participating in a public employee retirement system 27 deferred retirement option plan on July 1, 2011, or a member who has retired and commenced receiving benefits in any month between January 2011 and June 28 29 2011: (a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the 30 31 contrary, should an age or service retirant return March 1, 1986, or later, to employment in a position covered by the firemen's fund from which he or 32 33 she retired, no pension payments shall be paid him or her for the period of 34 such reemployment, and he or she may make member contributions to the system 35 as if he or she were an active member during such reemployment.;

(b)(1) (2)(A) If reemployment terminates before the retirant has

1	rendered sufficient reemployment to accumulate at least three (3) years of
2	credited service had he or she been an active member during such
3	reemployment, the payment of his or her pension shall resume upon such
4	termination, under the form of payment in force at the beginning of
5	reemployment and in an amount as it would be had he or she not been

8	contributions based upon any member contributions he or she may have made
9	during such reemployment.; and

11	rendered sufficient reemployment to accumulate three (3) years of credited
12	service had he or she been an active member during such reemployment, then
13	effective upon completion of such reemployment, his or her retirement shall
14	be canceled and the former retirant shall again become an active member.
15	(2) (B) Upon resuming active membership, the service and
16	contributions and pay records during reemployment shall be added to the
17	member's records as they were at retirement.
18	(b) Except as provided in subsection (a) of this section, a member who
19	<u>elects</u> to return to employment in a position covered by the firemen's pension
20	and relief fund shall agree to:
21	(1) Forfeit his or her retirement benefits while employed in a
22	position covered by the firemen's pension and relief fund; and
23	(2) Forfeit receipt of credited service during the period he or
24	she is employed in a position covered under firemen's pension and relief
25	<u>fund.</u>
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
