10	(B) A hands-free wireless telephone or device may be a		
11	permanent or temporary part of the wireless telephone or other wireless		
12	communication device.		
13	(C) A hands-free wireless telephone or device may require		
14	the use of either hand to activate, deactivate, or initiate a function of the		
15	wireless telephone or other communication device;		
16	(4) "Wireless interactive communication" means talking, typing,		
17	text messaging, emailing, or accessing information on the Internet with a

29	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 51, Subchapter 16 is		
30	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
31	27-51-1609. Restrictions in school zones.		
32	(a) Except as provided under subsection (b) of this section, a driver		
33	of a motor vehicle shall not use a handheld wireless telephone while		
34	operating a motor vehicle when passing a school building or school zone		
35	during school hours when children are present and outside the building.		
36	(b) A driver of a motor vehicle who is passing a school building or		

1	school zone during school hours when children are present and outside the		
2	building may use a handheld wireless telephone while operating a motor		
3	vehicle for an emergency purpose.		
4	(c) A driver of a motor vehicle is not to be stopped or detained by		
5	law enforcement solely to determine compliance with this section.		
6			
7	SECTION 4. NOT TO BE CODIFIED. This act applies to all violations		
8	committed on and after October 1, 2011.
