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24 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 25 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act provides for the 26 creation of a surcharge upon commercial mobile radio service providers per 27 subject telephone number per month to support the Telecommunications Equipment Fund, and that the optimal time to implement this surcharge is at 28 the beginning of the state's fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is 29 30 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2011. 31 32 33 34

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
