## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PROJECT  
9 DISBURSEMENTS FOR THE ARKANSAS NATURAL RESOURCES  
10 COMMISSION WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN  
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 35 OF  
12 2010; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS NATURAL RESOURCES  
16 COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - WATER, WASTE DISPOSAL AND POLLUTION  
23 ABATEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Natural Resources  
24 Commission, to be payable from the Water, Waste Disposal, Pollution  
25 Abatement, Administrative and Research Facilities Construction Fund, for  
26 project disbursements of the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission which  
27 shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section  
28 8 of Act 35 of 2010, the following:

34 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and



1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7  
8 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16  
17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
18 Assembly, that appropriations provided by the General Assembly for the  
19 operations of the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission are, due to  
20 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Natural Resources  
21 Commission to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the  
22 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas  
23 Natural Resources Commission to continue such services; and that a delay in  
24 the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
25 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
26 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
27 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
28 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

29 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
30 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
31 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
32 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
33 the veto.
