TO ALLOW PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS FLEXIBILITY IN SCHOOL START DATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO ALLOW PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS
FLEXIBILITY IN SCHOOL START DATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-10-106(a)(1), concerning the dates for the beginning of the school year, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(1)(A) In each school year, the first day of the school year for student attendance in the public elementary and secondary schools of the State of Arkansas shall begin:
(i) no-earlier than 0 or after the Monday of the week in which August 19 falls;
(ii) Not earlier than August 14; and
(iii) no Not later than August 26.
(B) If, however, August 18 falls on a Monday, school may begin on that date. The date for beginning the school year shall be determined by the board of directors of the school district.
(C) Labor Day shall be celebrated as a school holiday in all the school districts of the state, and school shall not be held on that date.
