1	(2) Any retirement annuity previously due from the system shall	
2	be terminated upon the effective date of the rescission.	
3	$(e)(1)(\Lambda)$ If a retirant who has elected to rescind his or her	
4	retirement terminates covered employment before he or she has accumulated at	
5	least one (1) year of additional credited service, the member's retirement	
6	benefits shall resume at the same benefit amount prior to the rescission.	
7	(B) If the member retires again before serving the	
8	required additional one (1) year of service under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of	
9	this section, the system shall refund without interest:	
10	(i) A member contribution that is credited to the	
11	system after the election to reseind retirement; and	
12	(ii) A member contribution that is not included in	
13	the member's retirement benefits.	
14	(2) If reemployment terminates after the end of the fiscal year	
15	in which the former retirant has accumulated at least one (1) year of	
16	additional credited service, the rescinded member shall receive an annuity	
17	that has been recalculated according to the benefit formula in effect at the	
18	time of the termination of reemployment.	
19	(f)(1) Λ retirant under § 24-7-702 may rescind the decision to retire	
20	and may elect to participate in the Teacher Deferred Retirement Option Plan	
21	beginning in the next fiscal year after the date the member meets the	
22	eligibility requirements.	
23	(2) If a rescinded member terminates covered employment before	
24	he or she is entitled to at least one (1) year of additional credited	
25	service, then the member shall forfeit any additional benefit accruals	
26	eredited after the effective date of rescission.	
27	(g) The election to rescind under this section may be exercised only	
28	once by the member or retirant.

30	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
31	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the	
32	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are badly in need of revision and	
33	updating to bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy;	
34	that such revision and updating is of great importance to members of the	
35	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and to other citizens of the State of	
36	Arkansas; that the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates on a July 1 to	

2	System plan work best if the changes are made at the beginning of a fiscal
3	year; and that this act is necessary in order to maintain an orderly system
4	of benefits for the members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System.
5	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for
6	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
7	effective on July 1, 2011.
