13	(a) <u>(l)</u> Should any If a change, omission, or error in the records <u>of</u>
14	<u>the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System</u> result <u>results</u> in a member, a
15	retirant, an annuitant, a beneficiary, or an alternate payee receiving
16	benefits or other distributions from the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System
17	benefit participant, employer, or the system having received an overpayment
18	or underpayment of any obligation, liability, contribution, or other right to

1	administrative action, cause of action, request to enforce, change, or modify
2	an obligation, duty, benefit calculation, designation, refund, contribution,
3	service credit or other right arising under this subchapter shall not be
4	valid unless commenced within the look-back period unless the system
5	determines that the justification to commence the process is due to
6	intentional nondisclosure, fraud, misrepresentation, or criminal act.
7	(d) The board or its designee may make adjustments to the employer,
8	member, and system records beyond the look-back period if the board
9	determines that the time limitation imposed by the look-back period will
10	result in a manifest injustice in a specific case.
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12	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
13	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the
14	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System statutes are in urgent need of revision to
15	bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy; that finality
16	of decisions and calculations after four (4) fiscal years are needed to
17	better allocate system resources; that this revision is of great importance
18	to benefit participants and employers of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement
19	System and to other citizens of the State of Arkansas; and that this act is
20	necessary in order to maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members
21	of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is
22	declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the
23	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective July 1, 2011.
