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26	SECTION 1. Ar	kansas Code 27-14-1012 is amended to rea	d as follows:

28	(a)(1) An app	licant may apply, in person or by mail,	for the issuance
29	of permanent license	plates or renewal of license to the rev	enue collector
30	office in the county	where he or she resides or to the Direc	tor of the
31	Department of Financ	e and Administration.	
32	(2) Aft	er the issuance of a permanent license p	late, an
33	applicant may apply	for renewal by transmitting copies of th	e required
34	documents by facsimi	le machine over the telephone lines and	by authorizing
35	the registration fee	and any additional handling fee imposed	to be charged to
36	his or her credit ca	rd :	

1	(A) Transmitting the required documents and the
2	registration fee by mail to the applicant's local revenue office or to the
3	director;
4	(B) Transmitting the required information electronically
5	using the electronic online registration process provided by the Department
6	of Finance and Administration and authorizing the registration fee to be
7	charged to the applicant's credit card; or
8	(C) Providing the required information using the telephone
9	registration process provided by the department and authorizing the
10	registration fee to be charged to the applicant's credit card.
11	(b) $\underline{(1)}$ Not less than thirty (30) days before the expiration of the
12	license, the director shall notify the owner of a registered motor vehicle
13	subject to this subchapter at the last address of the owner of the motor
14	vehicle as such owner's name and address appear on the records of the Office
15	of Motor Vehicle, but the director is not required to go beyond the face of
16	the last registration statement.
17	(2) The notice shall be sent by:
18	(A) Regular mail to the most recent address of the owner
19	of the motor vehicle as the owner's name and address appear on the records of
20	the Office of Motor Vehicle as the address provided at the last registration
21	or reported as a change of address as required by § 27-14-1019; or
22	(B) Email to the email address provided to the director by
23	the motor vehicle owner in connection with a consent to receive the annual
24	motor vehicle registration renewal notice by email.
25	(c) (1) A proper application for registration or renewal by mail must
26	be postmarked not later than fifteen (15) days before the date for renewal to
27	allow time for processing.
28	(2)(A) A proper application for renewal by facsimile machine
29	must be received not later than seven (7) days before the date for renewal to
30	allow time for processing.
31	(B) The time and date printed by the facsimile machine of
32	the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall be
33	evidence of the date and time of the application.
34	(d) The director is authorized to impose a first class postage fee for
35	handling the issuance of all new licenses or renewals by mail and to impose
36	an additional fee to recover any credit card fees charged by credit card

1	companies.		
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3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-1013 is amended to read as follows:		
4	27-14-1013. Renewals of registration.		
5	The owner of any permanent license plate issued by the Director of the		
6	Department of Finance and Administration may renew his or her registration:		
7	$\underline{(1)}$ in \underline{In} person or by mail at a county revenue office or with		
8	the director or, where available, by facsimile machine transmission during		
9	any day from forty-five (45) days prior to the date on which his or her		
10	registration shall expire. The applicant, upon receiving notification by the		
11	director of his or her new permanent registration date, shall, within the		
12	time prescribed by the director, pay a twelve-month registration fee;		
13	(2) Electronically, using the electronic online registration		
14	process provided by the Department of Finance and Administration; or		
15	(3) By telephone, using the telephone registration process		
16	provided by the department.		
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18	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 27-14-1014(a)(1), concerning application		
19	forms for renewal of registration, is amended to read as follows:		
20	(a)(1) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration		
21	shall $\frac{\mbox{\footnotesize mail}}{\mbox{\footnotesize send}}$ application forms for all renewals of registration under this		
22	subchapter to the last address of the owner of the motor vehicle as the		
23	owner's name and address appear on the records of the Office of Motor		
24	Vehicle. by:		
25	(A) Regular mail sent to the most recent address of the		
26	owner of the motor vehicle as the owner's name and address appear on the		
27	records of the Office of Motor Vehicle; or		
28	(B) Email sent to the address provided to the director by		
29	the motor vehicle owner in connection with a consent to receive the annual		
30	motor vehicle registration renewal notice and application forms by email.		
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32	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 27-14-1021 is amended to read as follows:		
33	27-14-1021. Annual notification of requirements.		
34	(a) From and after January 1, 1998, the The Director of the Department		
35	of Finance and Administration shall $\frac{1}{1}$ eause to be $\frac{1}{1}$ mailed $\frac{1}{1}$ to each vehicle		
36	owner in this state the following information:		

1	(1) Notification of the requirement that each vehicle must be		
2	assessed and personal property taxes must be paid annually;		
3	(2) Notification of the procedure and time period for annual		
4	assessment of personal property;		
5	(3) Notification of the requirement that proof of liability		
6	insurance is required and must be maintained at all times in the vehicle; and		
7	(4) Notification of the penalties contained in Arkansas law for:		
8	(A) Failure to assess the vehicle or pay personal property		
9	taxes due;		
10	(B) Failure to maintain liability insurance coverage on		
11	the vehicle; and		
12	(C) Operation of an unsafe vehicle.		
13	(b) The director may comply with the requirements set forth in		
14	subsection (a) of this section by including the information in the annual		
15	vehicle registration renewal notice sent to each vehicle owner by:		
16	(1) Regular mail; or		
17	(2) If the motor vehicle owner has given his or her consent,		
18	email.		
19	(c) The director shall also cause to be displayed, in conspicuous		
20	fashion, at each revenue office in this state, the information set forth in		
21	subsection (a) of this section.		
22	(d) The director shall also, not later than January 1, 1998, provide		
23	such notice as is set forth in subsection (a) of this section, as well as the		
24	new procedures, to all new and used vehicle dealers in this state.		
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
